Level 1

One word per page or simple sentences with repetitive patterns.

Simple words with only one or two syllables.

A large, clear font.

Pictures or photographs that closely match the text and fill most of the page.

Level 2

Simple storylines and sentences with repetitive patterns.

There may be more than one character talking.

A medium sized font.

Large pictures or photographs that explain the text.

Level 3

Has a more complex storyline with multiple sentences.

May have dialogue between characters.

A small to medium font.

Illustrations support the text and may offer additional information.

Level 4

First chapter books.

Conversations among many characters.

Small to medium font.

Only a few illustrations.
